Title: Scholarship & Recruitment Manager

Organizational Overview:

Based in Boston, From the Top (FTT) is America's largest national platform dedicated to celebrating the stories, talents, and character of classically-trained young musicians. Through live events, NPR and YouTube broadcasts, scholarships, and leadership programs, we empower these extraordinary young people to engage and inspire music lovers of all ages.

Summary:

The Scholarship & Recruitment Manager leads From the Top's national recruitment efforts and manages the Jack Kent Cooke Young Artist Award program, one of the most prominent precollegiate scholarship programs in the country. This manager works hand in hand with the Content and Production Department, reporting to the Music Producer and managing a two-person team including the Scholarship Assistant and the Recruitment & Alumni Relations Assistant.

Key duties and responsibilities:

Working closely with staff across the organization, this manager will:

- Cultivate and manage recruitment contacts and strategy for admissions and scholarship programs for Boston, regional, and national markets
- In conjunction with the Music Producer and Admissions Assistant, ensure smooth operation of the admissions process, systems, and communication for applications to all From the Top performance and program opportunities
- Organize and travel to live auditions around the country, particularly to summer music festivals in July and August
- Oversee management and implementation of one of the most prominent pre-collegiate scholarship programs in the country, the Jack Kent Cooke Young Artist Award, which distributes \$200,000 of scholarships each year to young musicians with financial need. This includes:
 - Providing ongoing communication and grant and program management reports to the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation
 - Reviewing financial, academic, and character components of all scholarship applicants
 - Making final scholarship award determinations in agreement with our Music Producer



- Managing program staff and budget
- Collaborating closely with the Finance Department to oversee the facilitation of financial procedures including the distribution of scholarship funds
- Managing alumni relation efforts for scholarship recipients
- Work closely with the Director of Marketing & Communications to develop print and online advertisement campaigns to broaden awareness of the scholarship and admissions process
- Analyze and evaluate results of scholarship and recruitment programs
- Conduct performer pre-interviews as needed

Requirements & Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in related field required
- A minimum of 2+ years of experience in admissions or financial aid required;
 background and/or interest in classical music performance and music education preferred
- Experience working with youth preferred; strong interest in working with highachieving, low-income young musicians highly desirable
- Experience managing a team preferred
- Strong computer literacy and database experience required; Raiser's Edge experience highly desirable
- High level of written and oral communication skills; ability to communicate with wide spectrum of stakeholders: pre-teen and teenage students, parents, music teachers, and arts administrators
- Must demonstrate high level of discretion in handling sensitive personal and financial information
- Experience communicating with people from a variety of backgrounds
- Valid driver's license, willingness to drive, and ability to travel nationally required
- Ability to lift and carry equipment weighing up to 30 lbs.
- Must complete criminal background screening

Salary and Benefits: This is a full-time (40 hours/week), exempt, salaried position with benefits including medical insurance, Paid Time Off (PTO), and holidays.
